

## **Advising Sheet for Journalism: An Add-On Endorsement.**

Candidates for the endorsement in Journalism will meet the licensure requirements by completing the requirements for a primary endorsement in secondary education and will take following courses in journalism: 15 credits total

## 9 Credits:

- JOUR 101 Introduction to Mass Communications,
- JOUR 201 Introduction to Reporting, and
- **JOUR 202** *Introduction to Digital Journalism*

## 6 Credits: Suggested Courses

- JOUR 270 Digital Media and Society, JOUR 231 Communication Theory, JOUR 351 Editing for the Print Media, JOUR 357 Magazine Feature Writing, JOUR 365 The Broadcast News Online, or JOUR 377 Media Management and Entrepreneurship.
- Students may work in an editorial, full-time reporting or managerial position for W&L's newspapers, radio station, cable channel, or yearbook for one semester in lieu of completing 3 elective course credits toward the endorsement.

The candidates will complete the appropriate professional coursework in education for their primary endorsement.
