

The Washington and Lee Student Health Center has issued recommendations to the University community on managing potential cases of the H1N1 virus. Students and employees should self-isolate if they are exhibiting symptoms of an influenza-like illness. The absence of infected persons from daily activities may help prevent a wide-spread outbreak of illness in our community.

For students who have scheduled on-campus interviews, Career Services will excuse those who have symptoms of an influenza-like illness on the day of the interview, provided the student notifies Career Services in advance. We ask that employers understand the need for these students to remain self-isolated and not allow interview cancellations to reflect poorly on the students affected by these circumstances. We also encourage any employers and guest speakers who are exhibiting signs of illness to reschedule interviews, recruiting events and programs to another time.
