

# DAY 1~FRIDAY~DECEMBER 27 USA/SAN JOSE

Your journey begins as you board your aircraft en route to San Jose. Upon arrival, you will be escorted to your accommodation, the Double Tree by Hilton Cariari Hotel San Jose, where the rest of your day is at your leisure.

### Day 2~Saturday~December 28

## TORTUGUERO NATIONAL PARK/TORTUGUERO VILLAGE

Your morning begins early with a drive en route to Tortuguero. You will stop for breakfast at the El Ceibo Restaurant in Guápiles. Breakfast here is a delicious start to the day, featuring classic Costa Rican options like "gallo pinto" (rice and beans mixed with spices), served with eggs, fresh tortillas, and fried plantains. You can also enjoy freshly brewed Costa Rican coffee, tropical fruit platters, and freshly squeezed juices. The morning atmosphere is serene, with views of lush greenery, making it a refreshing spot to begin your day. Resume your drive to the Pavona Deck for your scenic boat ride to Tortuguero National Park and your hotel. Once you check-in, you can enjoy lunch and prepare for the afternoon.

This afternoon, visit the Tortuguero village. The tour begins at the Lodge with a boat ride to Tortuguero village, where a knowledgeable guide will lead you on a walk through this unique community. Visiting the vibrant town of Tortuguero, you can immerse yourself in the local culture, gaining insight into its residents' daily lives and customs. Once a hub for hunting, fishing, and agriculture for various ethnic groups like the Miskito, Miskito-Zambo, and Afro-Caribbean populations, Tortuguero has evolved into a community focused on preserving its natural surroundings. The tour takes you through the town's history, from mid-20th-century wood sawing to the present

history, from mid-20th-century wood sawing to the present, where tourism plays a vital role in conservation efforts.

You'll visit the local museum and the Turtle Research to gain a deeper understanding of the vital conservation efforts focused on sea turtles, particularly the endangered green, leatherback, and hawksbill turtles that nest on the nearby beaches. The center monitors and protects these species, working with local researchers and volunteers to ensure their survival. The Renowned naturalist Archie Carr, author of the 1956 book *The Windward Road*, did much of his work on sea turtles at Tortuguero. He was instrumental in establishing the Caribbean Conservation Corporation (CCC) - his







"Casa Verde" research station is still here. Tortuguero gets its name from the Spanish word for turtle and is the most important nesting site in the entire western half of the Caribbean for the green turtle – which gathers in large numbers to nest between July and October. Other species of sea turtles that also nest on the wide beaches of the park and refuge are the leatherback and hawksbill. The green turtle population is believed to have come perilously close to extinction in the 1960s when nearly every female turtle arriving to nest in Tortuguero was taken for the export market for turtle soup. CCC was established in 1959



specifically to study and protect Caribbean green turtles. Working closely with the Costa Rican government, CCC helped establish Tortuguero National Park in 1970, a move that offered protection to the turtles and strictly limited the number of turtles that could be taken from the biologically rich environments.

Evergreen Lodge is located in the heart of Tortuguero National Park, surrounded by lush tropical rainforests and the tranquil canals of Tortuguero. This eco-friendly lodge offers an immersive experience in nature, perfect for those who want to explore Costa Rica's rich biodiversity. The lodge has 55 comfortable rooms, each with a private bathroom, hot water, ceiling fan, and large windows to take in the views of the surrounding jungle. Enjoy the swimming pool, a restaurant offering a variety of local and international dishes, and a bar for relaxing after a day of adventure. Complimentary Wi-Fi is available in common areas.

### DAY 3~SUNDAY~DECEMBER 29 TORTUGUERO NATIONAL PARK

This morning, hop on board your electric-powered boat and prepare to explore the enchanting canals of Tortuguero National Park. Discover the rainforest and its labyrinth and network of natural waterways full of flora and fauna without getting off the boat and walking through muddy trails. The tour will lead you through the living jungle that stretches over the narrow canals formed by the rivers born in the high



mountains, making their way to the sea. Common sightings here are monkeys, crocodiles, iguanas, and sloths. The canals are also considered a bird

watcher's paradise, so keep your eyes open.



This system of rivers and man-made channels parallels the coast and cuts through beautiful primary forests. One of the wettest regions in the country, it is also one of the areas with the most incredible biological diversity. There are 11 distinct habitats, ranging from coastal woodland and berm to very moist high forest and swamp forest where the predominant species can grow up to 130 feet tall, such as wild tamarind. The water hyacinths are so thick in places that boats cannot get through.



Resident avian species include the Green Macaw, which prefers to move about in the upper canopy of the rainforests and mainly feeds on seeds of the wild almond tree, Great Curassow, Keelbilled Toucan, Turkey Vulture, White-necked Jacobin, Violaceous Trogon, Great Tinamou which is a very terrestrial bird that feeds on seeds, berries and small insects caught in its flight path, Neotropical Cormorant, Anhinga, and Montezuma Oropendola. The channels and marshes are home to seven species of land turtles, which can be seen sunning themselves on logs in the middle of the water or on islands of floating vegetation. You can also find the West Indian manatee - one of the most endangered Caribbean species, crocodiles, caimans, and green iguanas. There is also a great variety of crustaceans and 30 freshwater fish species, including the gar, considered a living fossil, eel, bull shark, Caribbean snook, tarpon, red snapper, and mackerel.

This afternoon, take a guided tour to explore the unique network of trails at the Evergreen Lodge that allow you to immerse yourself in the lush tropical rainforest. As you walk along the trails, you'll be surrounded by towering trees, dense vegetation, and the sounds of the jungle. The paths often wind through the forest, offering glimpses of the region's vibrant wildlife, including monkeys, sloths, and colorful frogs. Keep your eyes peeled for vibrant birds which are often spotted perched in the trees. You can also encounter smaller species like Rufous-tailed Hummingbirds and water birds like Green Herons and Great Egrets near the canals.

### DAY 4~MONDAY~DECEMBER 30

# TORTUGUERO/PAVONA DOCK/ARENAL VOLCANO

Bid farewell to Tortuguero this morning, as your boat takes you back to Pavona Dock for your drive to Arenal Volcano,

an iconic landmark in Costa Rica located within the Arenal Tilaran Conservation Area. It is one of the country's most recognizable peaks, known for its near-perfect conical shape. It rises to 5,437 feet (1,656 meters) and is surrounded by lush tropical rainforests and diverse landscapes. The region around Arenal Volcano features a variety of habitats, including grasslands, volcanic badlands, and rainforests. The volcano's slopes are home to an array of wildlife, including howler monkeys, toucans, and coatis. The park is renowned for its rich biodiversity, with many bird species and other exotic creatures like elusive jaguars and capuchin monkeys. The volcano is a prime destination for hiking and adventure, with trails that traverse old lava fields and rainforests, providing breathtaking views of the peak and its surroundings. The area



features geothermal hot springs heated by volcanic activity, offering a relaxing experience. Since its major eruption in 1968, which dramatically altered the landscape, the volcano has been relatively calm, yet its striking features and natural beauty remain a major draw for visitors.



This afternoon you will spend time at the Ecotermales Hot Springs. Nestled in the verdant rainforest near Arenal Volcano, this family-owned hot springs project offers a serene escape for guests. Surrounded by vibrant tropical flora, visitors can unwind in the mineral-rich thermal waters that flow naturally from the volcanic earth, providing a rejuvenating experience deeply connected to nature. As the day transitions into night, the visit culminates with a delightful buffet dinner featuring local cuisine, allowing guests to savor the authentic flavors of Costa Rica while enjoying the tranquil ambiance of the hot springs. This guided experience enhances your understanding of the volcano and deepens your appreciation for the area's rich biodiversity and natural beauty.

# Day $6\sim$ Wednesday $\sim$ January 1

#### ARENAL VOLCANO/GUACALILLO ESTUARY/MANUEL ANTONIO

This morning, you will drive four and a half hours and embark on a jungle boat tour with lunch through the Guacalillo Estuary and Tárcoles River, offering a close encounter with one of the largest populations of American crocodiles (Crocodylus acutus) in the Americas. Located on Costa Rica's Central Pacific Coast, this region is a vital mangrove ecosystem, with four species of mangrove trees lining the waterways. During the tour, you'll have the chance to observe crocodiles, some as large as sixteen feet, basking on the riverbanks or gliding through the water in their natural habitat.

The estuary and river are teeming with wildlife. With over 250 species of birds, including kingfishers, roseate spoonbills, and various species of herons, the area is a birdwatcher's paradise. The river is a critical feeding ground for both resident and migratory birds. At the same time, the mangroves provide a sheltered home for mammals, reptiles, and the striking basilisk lizard, known for its ability to run across the water. The diverse ecosystem thrives thanks to the mangroves, which filter water, prevent erosion, and serve as a nursery for marine life.

Afterward, you will continue your drive to Manuel Antonio.







Your accommodation, the Parador Nature Resort & Spa in Manuel Antonio, is a luxurious resort perched on a hilltop, offering sweeping views of the Pacific Ocean and surrounded by lush rainforest. 

#### ARENAL VOLCANO/MANUEL ANTONIO NATIONAL PARK

A highlight of the ride is a stop at a beautiful waterfall, where you can swim and relax before continuing your

journey. Riders must be at least 7 years old, and the tour is a great way to experience Costa Rica's diverse ecosystems from a different perspective.

Catch the waves with expert surf instructors in Manuel Antonio, one of the best surfing spots on Costa Rica's Pacific Coast. Whether you're a beginner or an experienced surfer, the warm waters and consistent waves offer the perfect environment to hone your skills. Instructors will provide all necessary equipment and teach you the basics of paddling, balancing, and catching waves, ensuring a safe and fun experience for all participants. Surf lessons can be tailored to individual skill levels, making this an exciting and accessible activity for all ages.

# THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT COSTA RICA

#### **Participants**

- Participants must be able to climb in and out of vehichles and boats unassisted. You should also be able to tolerate nature walks at an easy pace on uneven terrain, sometimes uphill, for three or four hours at a time in heat and humidity.
- The tour also includes trekking in the humid rainforest. Your guide will advise the degree of difficulty in the event you wish to not participate and substitute something else.
- You should be in good physical health to enjoy this destination to its fullest.

#### In general, this trip requires:

- Flexibility and good humor unexpected changes and/or glitches will occur.
- A spirit of adventure and curiosity.
- Interest in and willingness to appreciate a destination with a modest infrastructure and a range in the availability of modern comforts. That being said, some locations are nestled in absolute luxury where pampering is the norm.

**FINAL PAYMENT:** Final payment is due 95 days before departure (November 11, 2025) – you will receive a final invoice. Final payment is payable by check or wire transfer ONLY. Conditioned on receipt of final payment in full, all final documents and air tickets will be sent to you approximately two weeks prior to departure.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Your program does not include international airfare. If you require assistance, contact Classic Escapes.



**FREQUENT FLYER MILEAGE:** Check on the airline's website to enquire who their partners are. Obtain frequent flyer mileage on any of these carriers. Present your frequent flyer card for all flight check-ins and keep the boarding passes until you receive a statement with the mileage credit

**TRANSFERS:** Roundtrip airport transfers are included in the tour for guests arriving on group flights. If travelers make their own air arrangements, they will be subject to extra transfer fees.

**FLIGHT CONFIRMATION**: We strongly suggest that you reconfirm exact flight times with the carrier prior to departure. Air travelers are required to check in at least 2 hours prior to departure time for domestic flights and 3 hours for international flights and must report to the gate at least 30 minutes prior to departure time.
