

Day 1: March 29, 2016 - Depart the U.S.: Depart Washington IAD for Paris, France.

Day 2: March 30, 2016 - Paris: Welcome to France. Jet Vacations' representative will personally greet you and arrange your transfer to your luxury sailing "space ship" in Paris. After you've comfortably settled in your cabin, we'll introduce our crew during our welcome cocktail party. You'll have dinner on board, and enjoy a free evening while we sail overnight to Vernon.

Day 3: March 31, 2016 - Vernon: This region of France gave rise to the Impressionist era and as such is famous for having evoked many beautiful paintings by some of history's most famous artists. This morning, visit Giverny, including entry to Monet's former residence and gardens. We'll return back on board for lunch and depart for Rouen. You'll travel through a landscape of steep cliffs, at the foot of which are a number of charming little villages that are typical of the region. We'll have dinner on board, and we'll remain in Rouen port overnight.

Day 4: April 1, 2016 - Rouen: After breakfast on board, join our guided visit of Rouen, the former capital of Normandy, where you'll discover the splendid cathedral, the delightful old guarter, and the historical market square where Joan of Arc was burned at the stake, among other sites. Lunch onboard and departure to Honfleur.

Day 5: April 2, 2016 - Honfleur: After breakfast onboard, depart for your guided tour to the beaches of the Normandy landings (lunch included). We'll depart by coach to reach Pointe du Hoc, passing the towns of Omaha Beach, Colleville-sur-Mer and its American cemetery. We will stop in Arromanches after lunch to watch the film "The Price of Liberty" and then return on board to enjoy dinner. We'll then depart on our cruise towards Caudebec-en-Caux, with the departure time depending on the tides.

Day 6: April 3, 2016 – Caudebec - En-Caux: After breakfast on board, join a guided tour, where you will venture to the village of Fécamp, set atop spectacular limestone cliffs plunging over 100 meters to the waters of the English Channel. And then visit the Benedictine Palace, built in 1822 to house the Benedictine monks and their 'magic' liquor; still a working distillery today with the famed Benedictine liqueur. Lunch and dinner onboard and overnight sailing towards Conflans.

Day 7: April 4, 2016 - Conflans: Visit the quaint village of Conflans located within a region home to an impressive collection of aristocratic Châteaux. Today explore the beautiful landscapes of this historic area with a visit to the magnificent Chantilly Castle for a guided tour of this remarkable château set amidst beautiful parklands. We will remain in port overnight.

Day 8: April 5, 2016 - Paris: You'll enjoy breakfast on board. Ensure your cameras are ready as you pass by the magnificent Paris skyline, pierced by the iconic Eiffel Tower, on your cruise into this romantic and most visited city in all of France. We'll spend our entire day touring Paris, beginning with a half-day guided tour exploring the legendary parts of the city, such as the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame, the Arc de Triomphe and the Champs-Elysées. We'll return on board for lunch. You'll have the afternoon free to explore Paris as you wish. We'll have the gala dinner on board, and will remain in port overnight.

Day 9: April 6, 2016 - Paris / U.S.: This morning you will be transferred by your Jet Vacations' representative to Paris CDG airport for your onward or homebound flight or to your post extension.

Day 10: April 07, 2016 - London: Breakfast at the hotel. Departure for a full day tour of the magnificent city of London. The city boasts the famous Roman Baths that inspired its name and beautiful Georgian architecture, from the 15th century Bath Abbey to the romantic Pulteney Bridge. Sitting on the slopes of the River Avon, it's easy to see why Bath draws so many visitors each year! The grand entrance to the Roman Baths is jaw-dropping, and you'll pass through this amazing doorway to begin your visit. The Baths date back to 40AD and still flow with water from Britain's only natural hot spring. You'll see the dazzling torch lighting ceremony as dusk falls (not available in summer) and sip Bath's healing waters in the Pump Room. Dinner on your own and overnight in London.

Day 12: April 09, 2016 - London / U.S.: Transfer from your hotel to London airport for your homebound flight (Breakfast).
