



## DIRECTED TEACHING RECOMMENDATION OF FINAL GRADE

The college supervisor is ultimately responsible for assigning directed teaching grades. In doing so, the supervisor solicits the input of the cooperative teacher and bases their evaluations on student teachers' demonstrated abilities at the conclusion of the student teaching assignment. The following criteria are used for final performance assessment:

- **Satisfactory:** To receive a (S) Satisfactory grade in Directed Teaching, student teachers must receive a **minimum** of **proficient** score on the overall ratings on The Framework for Teaching **final evaluation** including:
  - Planning and Preparation
  - Classroom Environment
  - Instruction
  - Professional Responsibilities
  
- **Unsatisfactory:** Any teacher candidate receiving a unsatisfactory or basic rating for any of the four main domains of The Framework for Teaching, shall receive an Unsatisfactory (U) grade in Directed Teaching.
