



Advising Sheet for Journalism: An Add-On Endorsement.

Candidates for the endorsement in Journalism will meet the licensure requirements by completing the requirements for a primary endorsement in secondary education and will take following courses in journalism: 15 credits total

9 Credits:

- **JOUR 101** *Introduction to Mass Communications,*
- **JOUR 201** *Introduction to Reporting,* and
- **JOUR 202** *Introduction to Digital Journalism*

6 Credits: Suggested Courses

- **JOUR 270** *Digital Media and Society,* **JOUR 231** *Communication Theory,* **JOUR 351** *Editing for the Print Media,* **JOUR 357** *Magazine Feature Writing,* **JOUR 365** *The Broadcast News Online,* or **JOUR 377** *Media Management and Entrepreneurship.*
- Students may work in an editorial, full-time reporting or managerial position for W&L's newspapers, radio station, cable channel, or yearbook for one semester in lieu of completing 3 elective course credits toward the endorsement.

The candidates will complete the appropriate professional coursework in education for their primary endorsement.
