Courses in Art History ARTH 101 and 102 or 267 and an ARTH course that covers art in periods earlier than those covered in ARTH 267 are required but substitutes can be approved if they cover similar content. One ARTH that deals with non-Western art.		
Courses in studio art: concentration	Candidate must have 12 credits in one area	
Courses in studio art: breadth	Candidate must have one course in 3 other areas.	
Courses in area related to visual arts.	One course in theater, dance, photography, architecture, or dance.
